

IDENTIFYING HOMELESS STUDENTS

The district identifies homeless students in the following manner:

1. During the enrollment and residency verification process (Every student must complete residency verification each and every school year)
2. Notification by student or parent during the school year
3. If an employee of the school district suspects that a student becomes homeless at some point during the school year, then the district takes ONE of the following actions:
 - a. The parent is interviewed using the parent interview sheet
 - b. The parent completes the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act Survey
 - c. The student completes the Student Residency Questionnaire
